



ADDENDUM VI
to MOU between Cal Poly Humboldt and the College of the Redwoods
Men's and Women's Rodeo

FOR COLLABORATION BETWEEN THE CALIFORNIA STATE POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY,
HUMBOLDT AND COLLEGE OF THE REDWOODS, RODEO PROGRAMS (RP)

Cal Poly Humboldt (Humboldt) agrees to partner with College of the Redwoods (CR) to develop men's and women's rodeo programs. This three-year partnership enables Humboldt and CR time to collaborate to raise funding, develop appropriate curriculum, hire coaches, and establish championship programs.

The programs will rely on CR and Humboldt in the following manner:

1. CR will hire a coach or coaches to lead an intercollegiate competitive men's and women's rodeo team in fall 2024.
2. Humboldt will hire a coach or coaches to lead an intercollegiate men's and women's rodeo team in fall 2024.
3. CR and Humboldt will establish a joint rodeo advisory committee composed of at least five community members. A member of the committee will chair the advisory committee. The committee will be advisory to the Athletic Directors and Coaches at CR and Humboldt.
4. CR and Humboldt will seek to become members of the National Intercollegiate Rodeo Association.
5. The Ferndale Fairgrounds will serve as the home for the CR and Humboldt rodeo teams.
6. CR and Humboldt will collaborate in marketing their rodeo programs and fundraising efforts, and present a unified front for the respective programs.
7. Both CR and Humboldt can both receive gifts-in-kind, with CR as the repository for animal-in-kind donations.
8. The Foundations at CR and Humboldt will have their own accounts for the acceptance of charitable donations and for ensuring that funds are utilized for the intended purpose. Each Foundation has processes in place to ensure this accountability as required by law, including oversight by members of the foundation boards.
9. CR and Humboldt will share in rodeo expenses as determined by the Athletic Directors.
